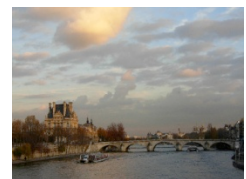
**ICICLE PRIZE: a Juried Festival for Film and Photography**

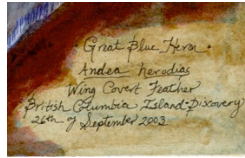

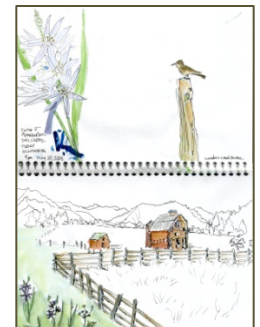
**THE CLYMER CAMP: OBSERVATIONS AND FIELD NOTES WITH HEATHER MURPHY**
