Walleye Cards, a naturalist notecard business, was founded in 1997 by **Heather A. Wallis Murphy** a wildlife biologist, watercolorist and nature journalist. Heather runs Walleye Cards from her home amongst the mountains and rivers of Leavenworth, WA. She holds a B.S. from the University of Washington, is a retired U.S. Forest Service wildlife biologist, and works as a consulting biologist and nature journal instructor.

Heather taught "Wildlife and Art of National Forests" to the *Smithsonian Institution's 2005 Folklife Festival* in WA, D.C. She also served as an Artist-In-Residence for the *North Cascades National Park* at Stehekin in 2007. Her nature column "Wildtales Country Journal" ran in *Country Pleasures Magazine*. Heather has taught workshops throughout the Northwest for the *UW's Botanic Gardens*, the *Wenatchee River Salmon Fest*, *Leavenworth Spring Bird Fest*, and the *North Cascades Institute*. She has worked with students at the *American School in Paris, France*; and at the *Lochaber Natural History Society, Scotland*. In 2010 Walleye Cards are featured on the *Environment for the Americas* website for migratory bird conservation - www.birdday.org - an international site.
